**Kansas City Parochial League  
Parents Code of Ethics**

The purpose of the Parochial League is to provide the opportunity for the youth to grow psychologically, emotionally, spiritually in the image of Christ through the benefits of a positive athletic experience. Keeping this in mind:

Parents and spectators must recognize that the Kansas City Parochial League is guided by the teachings of Jesus Christ and that they must demonstrate Christian values at all times.

Parents and spectators need to remember that they are setting an example for the children and must act in a Christian like manner at all times.

Parents and spectators must cheer for their own team, and refrain from cheering against the opposition.

Parents and spectators should encourage those around them to enjoy the game and uphold the expectations of good sportsmanship.

Parents and spectators shall demonstrate control of emotions at all times.

Parents and spectators should realize they do not have control over the decisions by the officials, and therefore, will not openly question their judgment.

Parents and spectators shall not make any derogatory comments or gestures to players, coaches, officials or gym moderators.

Parents and spectators must be a role positive role model at all times by supporting their team and not shouting instructions to players, coaches or officials. No coaching from the stands.

Any parent or spectator who interferes any Parochial League sponsored contest, may be asked to leave and or be suspended or barred from attending any Parochial League future contest.
